The Challenge

Since 2000, Hairy panic has become endemic on most farms and is more commonly found in stubbles rather than pastures.

Unlike summer weeds such as heliotrope, Hairy Panic is palatable, having a moderate to high grazing value, with digestibility around 65-70% and crude protein levels around 15-20%

Unfortunately, when consumed in large quantities, hairy panic can cause photosensitisation and jaundice, particularly in young sheep, often rendering them unsaleable.

www.facebook.com/Fabstock	The intake of loose licks depends on many factors including nutritional status and body condition of stock, feed quality and weather conditions. On average, expect sheep to consume 50g/head/day and cattle to consume 2000g/head/day. It is important that all stock in the mob have access to the product. When using small lick feeders, Fabstock recommend 1 per 20 cattle/50 sheep. If using specialist covered lick feeders (150kg cap.) allow 1 feeder per 40 cattle/200 sheep. If stock have not previously been exposed to loose licks, place feeders initially near water sources in the drier months and sheep camps in the wetter months. It is important that feeders are not allowed to run out of lick whilst stock are settling on to the lick, as this tends to encourage overconsumption.
